Mothers and Leaders are invited to enter photographs in a photo competition at LLLNZ's 2010 Conference

This year's Conference focuses on weaving connections. There will be several strands such as: mother-baby, family, cultural, national and international connections which could be explored photographically, as well as families in action and fun sibling arrangements. From a breastfeeding perspective, we are particularly interested in photos of mothers and babes with the mother's face and most of her body included.

- Each photo is to be clearly marked "Photo Competition"
- Please endorse the back with the entrant's name
- Include a separate A4 sheet with the following information;
 - entrant's name and address
 - names of those in the photograph and ages of children
 - photographer's name
 - brief captions or descriptions are welcome but not necessary
- Multiple entries may be sent but please limit the number of photos in one setting.
- Photographs should have been taken in the last three years and should not have been entered into a La Leche League competition before
- Photos taken by a professional photographer are not eligible
- Please send photos printed on photo paper. Winners are chosen by popular vote so to give your entries the best chance, quality photo paper is recommended.
- **Closing date is Saturday 18 September 2010.** Late entries may be accepted at the Conference but postal entries are preferred.
